Ecovative's Eben Bayer and Gavin McIntyre.

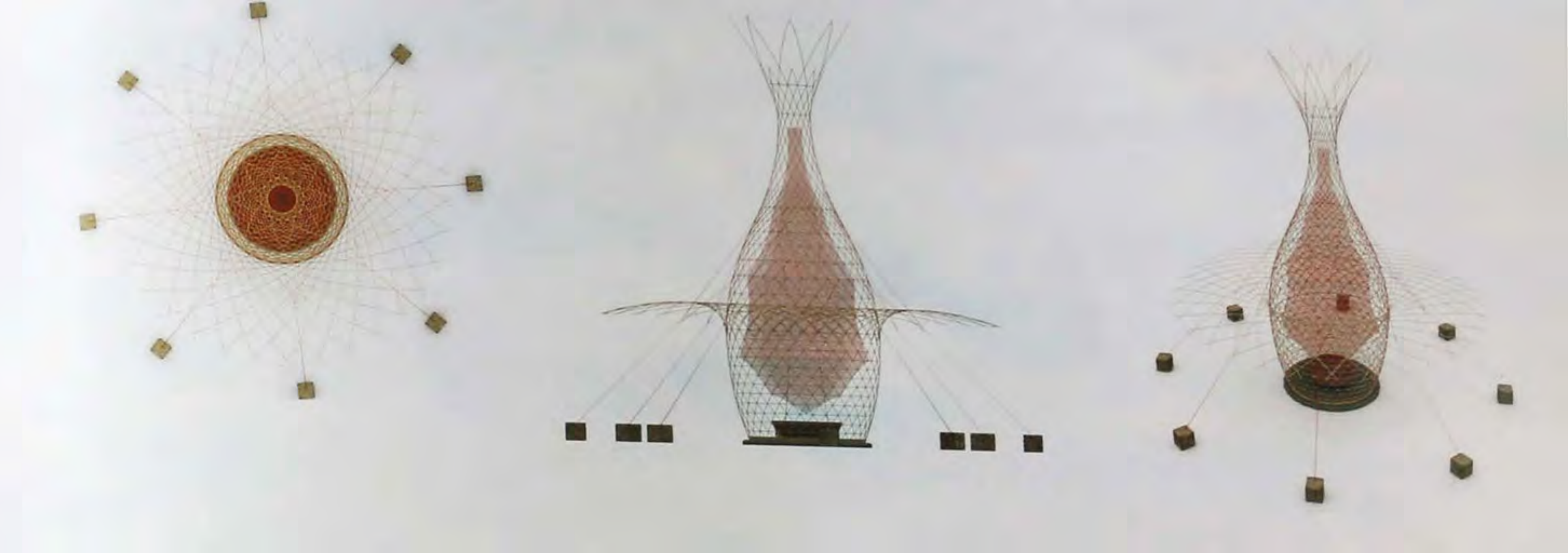






The structure, which takes its name from the Ethiopian Warka tree, comprises a 30-foot-tall frame around a perforated fabric, which can collect up to 100 liters of drinking water through condensation each day in specific climate areas. Five prototypes have been developed, with the goal to have structures in place in Ethiopia by 2015.
